LOCAL RULES

1. **Course Handicap (CH)** – Your Par 3 (CH) is the (CH) of the Leopard Creek Country Club Championship Course from White Tees for Men / Red Tees for Ladies, divided by 3 & rounded up for 0.66 values. The maximum Par 3 (CH) is 9.
2. **Tee Area Distances** – To the Centre of the Green.
3. **Out of Bounds** – The perimeter fence around the facility.
4. **Stone Walls Defining Greens** – Deemed to be in the Penalty Area.
5. **Wild Grass** - All areas of Wild Grass (veld) are deemed to be Red Penalty Areas. The edge of the Penalty Area starts where a maintained (mowed) area stops. In instances where a cart path is within the player's intended relief area (two club-lengths), then the cart path itself becomes the edge of the Penalty Area.
6. **Modern Local Rule B3** – If a player does not know whether his or her ball is in the Penalty Area on the 4th, 5th or 6th hole, then the player *may* play a provisional ball under rule 18.3.
7. **Drop Zones** – Additional relief option from Penalty Areas on the 4th, 5th, & 6th holes.
8. **G.U.R.** – Newly sodded areas, newly planted (staked) trees & tree bowls.
9. **Immovable Obstructions** – Include cart paths, sprinkler heads & irrigation satellite stations.
10. **Immovable Obstruction Close to the Green** – Relief when the Immovable Obstruction is on the line of play, within two club-lengths of the green & your ball is within two club-lengths of it.

COURSE ETIQUETTE

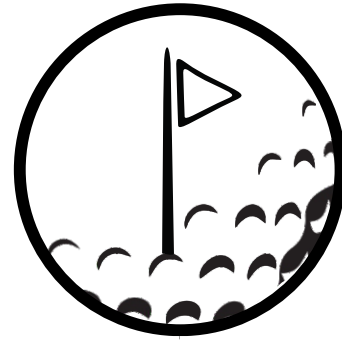
1. **Traditional golf attire** only. **Shirts** must be **tucked in** at all times / **caps** worn with **peak facing forward**.
2. **White socks** requisite with shorts / side-pocketed (**Cargo**) **shorts** or pants are **not permitted**.
3. Please **fix your pitch mark** on the greens & **fill your divots** with the sand supplied. If you can't fix yours, then fix or fill others.
4. A bunker rake is available on the cart. Please **rake with care after bunker play** & leave the bunker in better condition than you found it.
5. **Golf carts must remain on the cart paths at all times! Do not encroach** onto the course around **tee-and-green complexes at all**.
6. **Slow play is not tolerated** on this course. Keep up with the fourball ahead or invite faster players through. **Maximum time allotted** to complete 9 holes is **1h30**.
